Present and Future Sources of Financial Support

MuseDoma received initial funding from the J. Paul Getty Trust in the amount of \$400,000. To date these funds were used for the ICANN application and start-up activities. Additional funding is being sought from foundations and grant-giving bodies. Notwithstanding the above, it is the intention of MuseDoma to become self-sufficient -- paying all of its operating costs from membership and registration fees -- as soon as possible. In its business plan, MuseDoma estimates its main sources of revenue as follows:

MuseDoma expects to provide certain Web-support services to museums. These services are not expected to generate revenue, however, they are considered important to MuseDoma's overall goals to support education and communication in museums by encouraging and assisting museums to establish and maintain clear identities on the Internet, and by assisting their audiences in finding them and the resources they contain. No rate card has been developed for these services.
