Activities With Other Entities

(a) MuseDoma does not intend to provide grants to entities other than museums with tax-exempt status. MuseDoma may seek grants from government bodies as well as corporations, and these entities may not be 501(c)(3) organizations.

(b) MuseDoma will purchase, and may sell, its assets such as computers and software, from for profit companies.

(c) MuseDoma intends to rent facilities and equipment for both its offices and its registry services from for profit companies; no lease or contract is currently in place.

(d) MuseDoma does not plan on seeking any loans or loan guarantees.

(e) MuseDoma, if and when financially viable as determined by the Board of Directors, may reimburse Founder Members' contributions to the organization to the extent these contributions exceed the applicable membership fees. Both Founder Members -- the International Council of Museums and the J. Paul Getty Trust -- are non-profit organizations.

(f) MuseDoma may obtain services for community awareness and membership development from one or more for profit companies.

The companies that may be contracted with to provide the above-described services have not been identified as yet.
