Financial Accountability to Other Organizations

MuseDoma will submit copies of its annual financial reports to the Founder Members and membership. There may be some disclosure of financial information to ICANN.

MuseDoma's two founder members are the International Council of Museums ("ICOM") and the J. Paul Getty Trust ("Getty"). Both organizations are providing money and/or support staff during MuseDoma's start-up phase. Given the unique status of ICOM within the worldwide museum community and its critical role in ensuring that the .museum registry is operated on behalf of the worldwide museum community and the general public, ICOM has been designated two permanent seats on MuseDoma's Board of Directors. The Getty holds two seats on the MuseDoma Board of Directors and will continue to do so until MuseDoma is established as a viable, financially-independent entity. At that time, the Getty, in consultation with ICOM and MuseDoma's membership, will review its role on the Board of Directors.

It is possible that both Founder Members may provide staff and/or facilities after start-up for MuseDoma, although no long-term commitments have been made at this time.
